DAY 1

ARRIVAL TORONTO

A 25 KM

Upon arrival, meet and greet at the airport and transfer to the hotel. Check-in then meeting with your guide. Free dinner and accommodation.



DAY 2

TORONTO - NIAGARA FALLS - TORONTO

A 300 KM

Morning orientation tour of the Queen City. In this dynamic and cosmopolitan metropolis, you will discover the old and new City Hall, St. Michael's Cathedral, the University campus buildings, the CN Tower, etc. Then you will drive along Lake Ontario to Niagara Falls. Detour to the picturesque village of Niagara-on-the-Lake and lunch 'with a view' (PC). Then a mini-cruise on the Hornblower boat to the base of the Canadian Falls - an exhilarating experience. Afterwards, free time for your own discovery and end of the day, return to Toronto. Dinner and accommodation. (as an option: flight by helicopter over the falls).



DAY 3

TORONTO - THOUSAND ISLANDS - KINGSTON OR GANANOQUE

A 425 KM

This morning, departure for the beautiful region of the 1000 islands, by a road that follows the St. Lawrence River. Boarding for the discovery of an archipelago of 1800 islands in a very beautiful nature. Then visit Kingston and have lunch. Mini-cruise in the 1000 Islands region (1hr) then check-in at the hotel in Kingston. Free dinner and accommodation.



DAY 4

KINGSTON - OTTAWA - MONTREAL

A 360 KM

After breakfast, departure for Ottawa, the nation's capital. Orientation tour with a.o. the Parliament, the Rideau Canal, the National Arts Centre, the lively Byward Market area, etc. Lunch on site. In the afternoon continuation to Montreal. Specialty dinner (smoked meat) and accommodation downtown.



DAY 5

MONTREAL - QUEBEC AREA

A 270 KM

Guided tour on arrival in Montreal, the second-largest French city in the world. Named "Ville-Marie" by the first European settlers, Montreal is a city of contrasts, with the Old Port steeped in history and the modern districts of downtown hiding numerous buildings and an underground city of cafés, restaurants and cinemas. You'll take part in a guided tour of Montreal, discovering the city's center, then climb to Mount Royal for a strategic view of the city, St. Joseph's Oratory and Notre Dame Basilica, and a view of the Olympic Park from the 1976 Summer Olympics. Free time in the city and lunch. Continuation to Quebec City. Check-in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay.



DAY 6

QUEBEC AREA

A 100 KM

This morning, guided tour of the historical sites: Place Royale, the Citadel, the Plains of Abraham, the majestic Château Frontenac, the Dufferin Terrace from which you have a magnificent view of the river. Free time and lunch in old Quebec. Then, continuation to the Montmorency Falls, higher than Niagara Falls. At the end of the afternoon, return to the hotel and have dinner in a sugar shack with music and dance. Lodging.



DAY 7

QUEBEC - FREE DAY

A 80 KM

Free day in Quebec City to discover the city on your own. No meals. Lodging.

Optional: full-day excursion with meals included: your local guide will take you to visit the Huron Village, a reconstructed village where you'll learn about Amerindian traditions.

**DAY 8**

QUEBEC - FLIGHT TO VANCOUVER

A 25 KM

Depending on flight schedule, transfer to QUEBEC airport and flight to Vancouver. Lunch at leisure. On arrival, transfer to your hotel. Dinner on your own and accommodation in Vancouver.

**DAY 9**

VANCOUVER

A 10 KM

This morning, departure with your Skytrain 1day pass to Vancouver and to discover the beautiful Stanley Park and its totems. Stroll through the park and visit the Vancouver Aquarium. Lunch (in PC). Late afternoon, return to the hotel accompanied by your guide. Dinner and accommodation.

**DAY 10**

VANCOUVER - FERRY - VICTORIA

A 120 KM

Guided city tour of Vancouver: the theater and sports district, Granville Street, Canada Place (former Expo 86 pavilion, convention center and Alaska cruise ship terminal), Chinatown, Gastown, Yaletown and Granville Island Market. Lunch. Departure for Victoria on the Tsawassen ferry to Swartz Bay, passing many small islands rich in marine life. Orientation tour of Victoria: Parliament (seen from the outside), the Empress Hotel, the antique district, Chinatown, the residential district of Oakland, Marine Drive along the coast and Beacon Hill Park, and free time before departure. Check-in at your hotel. Overnight in Victoria.

**DAY 11**

VICTORIA - FERRY - WHISTLER - SQUAMISH (VDC)

A 505 KM

This morning, visit the famous Butchart Gardens. Lunch on site. Drive to Chemainus, then on to Nanaimo and board the ferry to Horseshoe Bay, then on to Squamish via the famous Sea to Sky Highway, one of Western Canada's most scenic routes, between sea and mountains. Stop at Shannon Falls, 335 m high. Check-in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Squamish.

**DAY 12**

WHISTLER - SOUTH THOMPSON INN RANCH - KAMLOOPS (VDC)

A 325 KM

This morning, departure for the pedestrian village of Whistler. Free morning in Whistler, the ski resort that hosted the alpine competitions at the Vancouver 2011 Olympic Winter Games. Depart for Cache Creek and Lillooet, mile zero of the Klondike Gold Rush Trail. Lunch en route. Continuation to 108 Mile Ranch or South Thompson Ranch. Settle into a wilderness ranch. Free time on site to enjoy activities or relax by the water. Dinner and overnight at the ranch.

**DAY 13**

SOUTH THOMPSON RANCH - WELLS GRAY NATIONAL PARK - JASPER (VDC)

A 450 KM

Drive to Wells Gray Provincial Park. Stop at Helcken Falls, 135m high and one of the most spectacular in British Columbia, as well as Spahar and Dawson Falls. Barbecue lunch at a Ranch in the Park. Continuation to Valemount and stop at Mont Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies (3953m). Check-in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Jasper or Valemount depending on the departure date.

Time change between British Columbia & Alberta: + 1 hour

**DAY 14**

JASPER (VDC)

A 120 KM

Spend the day discovering picturesque Jasper National Park. Begin your exploration at fabulous Pyramid Lake, then continue to the spectacular Maligne Canyon gorge. Continue on to the Maligne Lake area for an easy 3.2 km walk (1 to 2 hours). The Mary Schäffer Loop takes you to a viewpoint where there is also an exhibition on Mary Schäffer, a woman who became famous for her exploratory expeditions in the Canadian Rockies. The return trail winds through fragrant stands of pine, spruce and alpine fir. Lunch and then a beautiful cruise on Maligne Lake. Return to your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay.

Depending on the departure date, overnight stay may be in Valemount instead of Jasper.

**DAY 15**

JASPER - LAKE LOUISE (VDC)

A 350 KM

Departure for Lake Louise and Moraine Lake. Photo stops at Sunwapta and Athabasca Falls. Continue along the icefields on one of the most scenic roads in North America. Photo stops at Bow Lake, Glacier Bow and Peyto Lake. Picnic lunch en route. Arrival in the Lake Louise region at the end of the day. Check-in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight in the Lake Louise region.

Depending on departure date, overnight stay may be in Banff instead of Lake Louise.

**DAY 16**

LAKE LOUISE - BANFF - CALGARY (VDC)

A 210 KM

This morning's program includes a photo stop at Lake Louise and Lake Moraine. Departure for Banff, with an orientation tour of Banff, Banff Springs, Mount Sulphur and Hoodoos. Lunch stop. Continuation to Calgary with a short stop at the 1988 Winter Olympic Park. Orientation tour of Calgary: downtown, Eau Claire Market, Fort Calgary, Stampede Park, Heritage Park, etc. Check-in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Calgary.



DAY 17

DEPARTURE CALGARY

A 20 KM

Free time for a last walking tour through the city or for ultimate shopping. Free lunch and afterwards, transfer to the airport depending on the flight details. End of this extraordinary trip.
