# EAST CANADA & USA

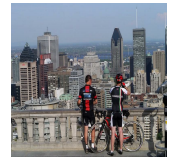
East Canada & USA. 15 days/14 nights. Start: Montreal - End: Toronto.

## DAY 1

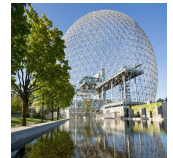


## DAY 2

**A** 260 KM

## DAY 4

QUÉBEC CITY - BANGOR

**A** 385 KM

## DAY 6

BANGOR - BOSTON

**A** 400 KM

South of Bangor, you can visit the wonderful Acadia National Park, situated at the Atlantic Ocean. Travel via the beautiful coast of Maine to Boston.

Time to visit the city. Start with the historic city center with the Faneuil Hall Marketplace, Copley Square, walk the Freedom Trail or enjoy an amusing lunch at 'Cheers'.



## DAY 8

BOSTON - NEW YORK

**A** 370 KM

Leave Boston and follow the route to Providence. Further via the picturesque coastal towns in Connecticut to the thriving metropolis, New York.

A whole day to visit the most important highlights of the city or participate in an optional city tour.



**DAY 10**

NEW YORK - WASHINGTON

**A** 385 KM

Time for the last shopping spree and you hit the road to Washington. A stop in Philadelphia is definitely worth it. Visit the Liberty Bell and Independence Hall.

A full day to explore the wonderful city. Visit the Capitole, the White House, the Smithsonian Institute, the Arlington Cemetery, and many more.

**DAY 11**
